Jorge Alderete, AKA Dr. Alderete, is a graphic artist, illustrator, author, designer, cultural manager, musician and sometimes photographer graduated from the School of Fine Arts in the Universidad Nacional de La Plata, Argentina, as a Designer in Visual Communication.

He is the co-owner of the independent record label Isotonic Records, specialized in instrumental rock. He has designed more than 100 albums for bands from Argentina (Los Fabulosos Cadillacs, Andrés Calamaro), Mexico (Cafe Tacuva, Lost Acapulco, etc), USA (Los Straitjackets) Spain, Finland, Greece, Peru, Italy, France , among others.

His work has been exhibited in many galleries around the world, in Mexico he also exhibited at the Museum of the City and Museum of Modern Art. In 2006 he open Kong, the first design store and gallery in Mexico. From 2006 to 2010 he was the curator of the Terraza space in the Cultural Center of Spain in Mexico.

In 2007, with Andres Amaya, he forms Plan B, the first Urban vinyl toy production company in Mexico.

In 2008 he published his book “I am a nobody” with the French publisher Black Cat Bones celebrating its first 10 years in Mexico City.

In 2009 he joins up with Clarisa Moura to open Vertigo Gallery, with exhibits focused in desing and Illustration.

He is part of the Sonido Gallo Negro musical ensemble since 2010.

The books Sonorama and Sonorama Dos (Ed. La Caja de Cerillos) compile their work on music, published in 2012 and 2018 respectively.

At the end of 2014 with Harkaitz Cano and the Basque musician Fermin Muguruza, his first graphic novel Black is Beltza, is published in Euskera, Catalan, Spanish and French (Bang editions). It also has local editions in Mexico (La Caja de Cerillos), Colombia (Rey Naranja), Argentina (Moebius publishers) and Japan (RocketMusic).

During 2016 he made the La Salvación tour with Fabulosos Cadillacs drawing alive during the shows of the band.

In 2018 the books Tike'a Rapa Nui and the South Pacific Islands is published by Rey Naranja, and No! his first children's book by the Mexican publishing house Alboroto.

Since 2015 he has been a member of AGI (Alliance Graphique Internationale).

He is the Beneficiary of the National System of Creators, of the National Fund for Culture and the Arts, FONCA 2018
